Chairman Binek called the meeting of the Stark County Park Board to order. All members present.

Pete Kuntz moved to approve the minutes. Ken zander seconded. All voted Aye and the motion carried.

Chairman Binek gave an update on the fairgrounds. Bids were received for the arena, grandstands, and concessions, projections were on target. PUD costs higher than projected.

The Fair Association is requesting \$300,000 to produce a full covered grandstands and lighting.

New chutes and pens will be installed for the main arena. The chutes and pens from the college arena will be torn down and used at the fairgrounds for practice etc.

Discussion was held to reclaim waterline to use for stock & arena. Chairman Binek is in discussion with the City of Dickinson regarding this matter.

Discussion was held who's obligation it is to carry insurance on the fairgrounds. The Stark County Park Board only pays NDIRF for the land and buildings.

Reed Reyman, St Joseph's Hospital, inquired if Stark County Park Board is still interested in purchasing back the land that was bought, and if Stark County Park Board is not interested they will put it up for sale.
