

NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION TUESDAY, JUNE 9, 2020

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 9th day of June, 2020, in the County of Stark, State of North Dakota, an election will be held for the purpose of nominating state, district, and county offices and electing city offices and school district boards.

This is a VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT ONLY election.

Valid Stark County residents interested in having a vote by mail ballot sent to them may visit the ND Secretary of State's website:

https://www.nd.gov/eforms/Doc/sfn51468.pdf to print an Absentee Ballot Application or call the Stark County Auditor at 701-456-7630 to have an application mailed to them. After printing, complete/sign and return to the Stark County Auditor, PO Box 130 Dickinson ND 58602. Completed/signed applications may also be returned by fax to 701-456-7634, emailed to khaag@starkcountynd.gov or deposited into the drop box located at 51 3rd St E, North parking lot of Courthouse.

Once Stark County receives the application, verifies the information is correct and signed, a ballot will be mailed to the voter. Voters are highly encouraged to **return their application by May 28, 2020** in order to receive their ballot in time. You can return your completed vote by mail ballot one of two ways:

The last day for the county to send out ballots is **June 4, 2020**. Time frame is of the essence.

2. Deposit in Secure Ballot Drop Box located at:

***Vote by Mail ballots must be postmarked no later than Monday, June 8, 2020 or deposited in Secure Drop Box no later than 4 pm, Tuesday, June 9, 2020.**
